2. Video Conference held by the Union Home Secretary with the Food Secretaries of States on 11.03.2026.

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**ORDER:**

In the circumstance reported in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> read above, and in view of the ongoing crisis in the Middle East, which is adversely affecting the global supply of crude oil and Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), there is a need for continuous monitoring of LPG availability, stock position and distribution within the State to ensure uninterrupted supply to Domestic consumers and Priority commercial segments.

2. In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Video Conference held by the Union Home Secretary & Secretary Petroleum & Natural Gas, with State Governments, it was advised to constitute State and District Level monitoring Committees, to monitor the supply and distribution of LPG.

3. Accordingly, Government after careful examination of the matter hereby constitute two Committees at the State and District levels for monitoring LPG supply, stock position, transportation and distribution, as follows:

**1. State Level Energy Supply Monitoring Committee**

**Functions of the State Level Committee:**

The State Level Energy Supply Monitoring Committee shall:

1. Continuously review the LPG supply position in coordination with Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs).
2. Monitor LPG stock position at bottling plants, storage depots and distribution points across the State.
3. Review the movement and distribution of LPG cylinders to ensure uninterrupted supply to consumers.
4. Coordinate with the Police Department for maintenance of law and order at LPG bottling plants and storage facilities by deploying RDOs/DSP rank officers.
5. Facilitate police escort to LPG transport vehicles wherever required, to ensure safe and timely transportation.
6. Daily situation report on Law and order to be furnished by DGP, TG to State Level Energy Supply Monitoring Committee in the prescribed format **(Annexure-II)**.
7. Oil Marketing Companies to provide daily situation report in the prescribed format **(Annexure -III)**.
8. Take necessary Legal action for prevention of diversion or unauthorized use of LPG cylinders.
9. Review supply constraints, if any, and advise the Government on measures required to ensure adequate LPG availability in the State.
10. I&PR to issue regular press briefings and releases to print electronic and social media. Fact check & Counter misinformation on social, electronic and print media.
11. Provide periodic appraisal and recommendations to the Government regarding LPG supply management.

**Functions of the District Level Committee:**

1. **Monitoring of LPG Supply:**  
Continuous monitoring of the availability and supply of LPG in the district in coordination with Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) and LPG distributors.
  2. **Review of Stock Position:**  
Daily review of the stock position at LPG storage points, distributor godowns, and other distribution points within the district.
  3. **Maintenance of Law and Order:**  
Ensuring maintenance of law and order at LPG godowns, storage facilities, and distribution points **by deploying DTs/RI/SI rank officers.**
  4. **Prevention of Hoarding and Diversion:**  
Taking necessary Legal measures to prevent hoarding, diversion, and unauthorized use of LPG cylinders.
  5. **Enforcement Action:**  
Initiation of appropriate enforcement action, including booking of cases under **Section 6A & 7 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955**, relevant sections of BNSS in instances of diversion or misuse of LPG cylinders.
  6. **Public Communication:**  
I&PR to issue regular press briefings and releases to print electronic and social media regarding LPG supply position in the district. Fact check & Counter misinformation on social, electronic and print media.
  7. **Reporting to State Level Committee:**  
Submission of daily situation report in the prescribed format **(Annexure -I)** to the State Level Energy Supply Monitoring Committee.
4. The State and District level committees shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
